

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ernest L. Du Pree, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Jackson Heights, county of Queens, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; Figure 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and Figure 4 is a top plan view thereof. I claim:
