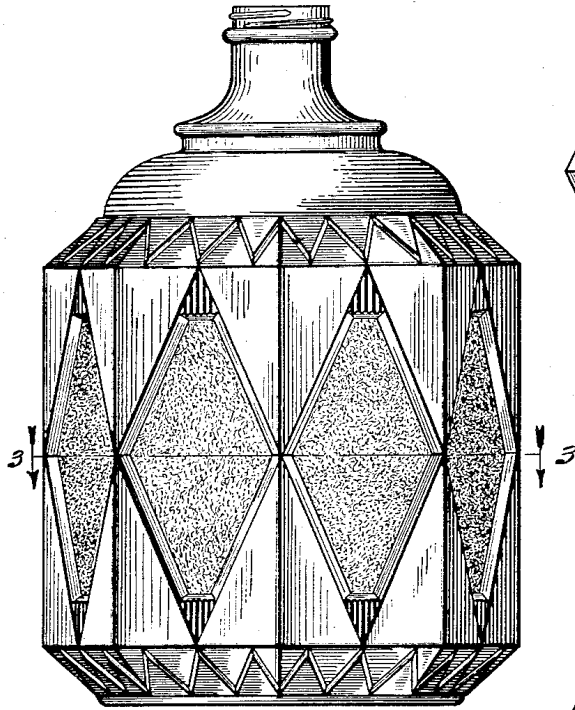

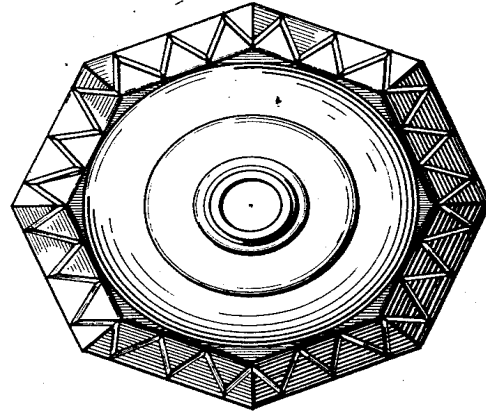

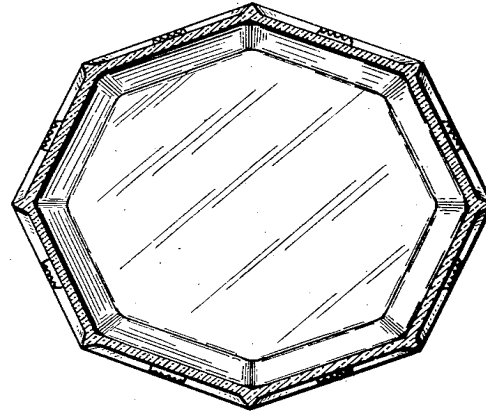
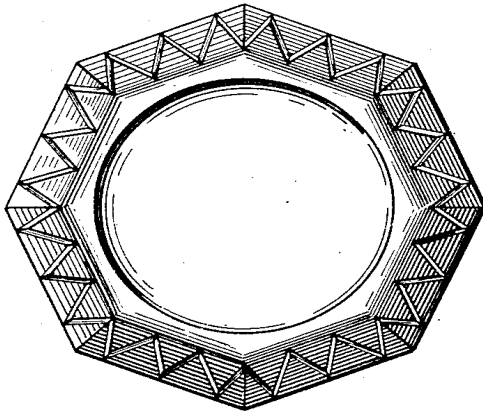

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE OR SIMILAR CONTAINER

Application filed December 26, 1929. Serial No. 33,925. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WALTER D. TEAGUE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Forest Hill, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle or Similar Container, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an elevation of a bottle, showing my new design; and Figs. 2, 3, and 4 are a plan, a horizontal section substantially on the line 3—3 of Fig. 1, and a bottom plan, of the bottle shown in Fig. 1.

I claim:
