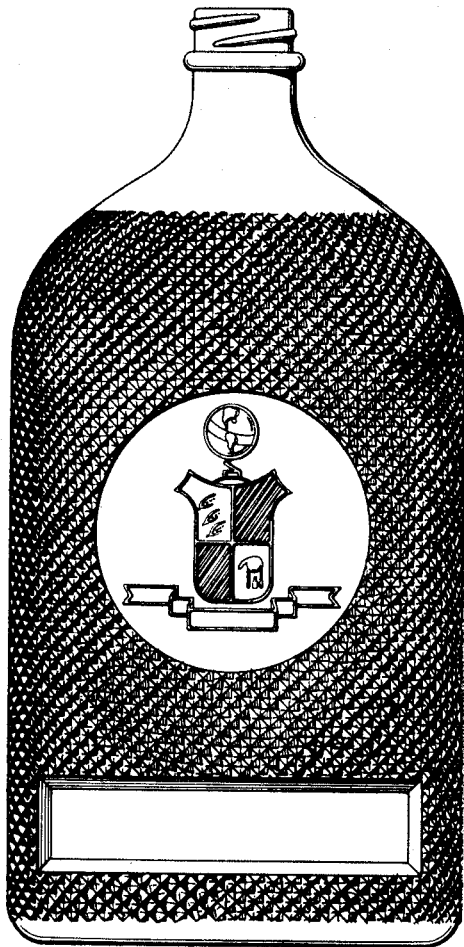

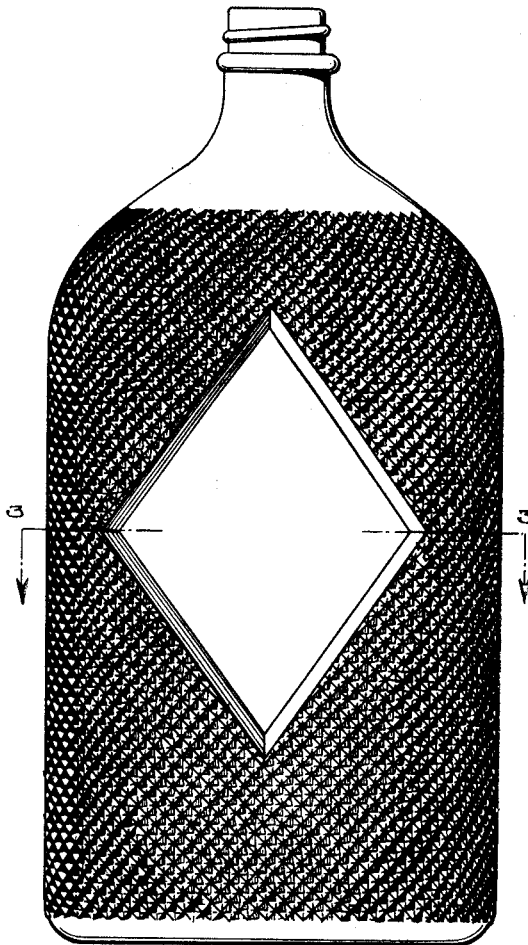
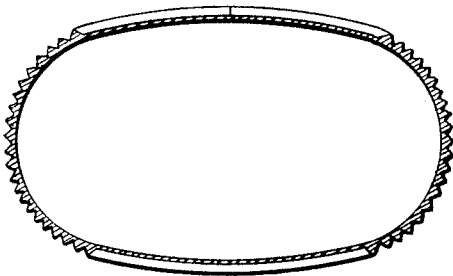

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK TREVOR KESSLER, a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof, in which:—

Figure 1 is a front view illustrating my new design for a bottle;

Fig. 2 is a rear view; and

Fig. 3 is a transverse sectional view on the line 3—3, Fig. 2.
